Inclusion is a priority in Europe; all member states have signed the UN Convention for the rights of people with disabilities and committed themselves to provide the conditions, at European level, for real inclusion.

The promotion of inclusive education and lifelong learning for learners with disabilities is one of the priority areas set up under the European Disability Strategy 2010-2020 adopted on 2010. Moreover, in the *Bruges Communiqué* the European Commission proposes to increase the possibilities for disadvantaged learners in VET by offering alternative pathways, innovative VET training, more Work-Based Learning (WBL) as highlighted in “Work-Based Learning in Europe, Practices and Policy Pointers” in the initial VET document (2013).

VET4ALL project objectives are focused on the training of teachers and staff working with students with disabilities/special needs to make the WBL experience more fruitful and to enhance the possibilities of gaining a job in the future, even in an European context. In details, VET4ALL aims to:

- Develop flexible pathways which connect the VET formal school curriculum to Work Based Learning for students with disabilities/special needs.
- Foster the implementation of ECVET principles and tools and develop an innovative approach to Mobility in order to facilitate access for students with disabilities/special needs.
- Increase the possibility for students with disabilities/special needs to participate to an EU Mobility Experience.
- Support enterprise mentors and staff during the WBL/internship experience of students with disabilities/special needs.

Project Outputs

1 VET4ALL Didactical Guidelines for training VET Staff working directly with students with disabilities/special needs.

2 VET4ALL Training Curriculum for training VET Staff working directly with students with disabilities/special needs during their WBL/internship experience.

3 VET4ALL In-Company Mentors Vademecum - a very practical tool to be distributed to Mentors in order to support students with disabilities/special needs during their WBL/internship experience.

4 VET4ALL Mobility Vademecum for Accompanying Persons of students with special needs. The aim is to provide support to the accompanying persons and even the hosting EU Enterprises on how to develop the Learning Outcomes acquired in a European context and give guidance on how to evaluate the students.
